


OUR UNIVERSITY CAMPUS.



We learn together in small groups. This enables individual coaching and mentoring between our students and course professors.




EXPERT GUEST SPEAKERS

This program prepares its graduates for leadership roles as (co)-founders as well as for entrepreneurial roles in established companies.


YOUR STUDY PATH AT A GLANCE.

Each course has a workload of 5 ECTS = 125 hours.










Mentality is a startup focused on improving the mental health of professional athletes and minimizing the stigma attached to mental health issues in the professional sports industry.



HEC SOCIAL BUSINESS CREATION.





THI CENTER OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP.




